Chart 1 Total entry for GCSE full course subjects, 2015 to 2024




Chart 2 Cohort size 2015 to 2024



Chart 3 Top ten GCSE full course subjects as a percentage of the total entry over the period 2015 to 2024



Chart 4 Top GCSE full course subject increases, 2015 to 2024 (entry greater than 100,000)


